This event may be shot as an individual competition and/or as Stage 1 of the 2019 – 2020 Countesthorpe Triple. The Countesthorpe Triple will be shot over three rounds – The Foxes Portsmouth, The Foxes Worcester and LAOFAC WA18m. A separate entry form is required for each event and also for the Countesthorpe Triple. Competitors are responsible for making sure that they enter each of the separate stages. Entries for the Countesthorpe Triple must be received by The Foxes before the end of the Portsmouth competition on 10th November 2019.

If you wish to take photographs or videos during the tournament, please register on arrival. If you do not want to be included in any photographs or videos, please let the registration desk know when you arrive.

Awards will be presented to Lady and Gentlemen archers in four categories (Recurve, Compound, Barebow, Longbow) depending on the number of entrants and at the discretion of The Foxes Archery Club. Other bow styles will be included in one of those four categories for the purpose of awards, but will be a separate category in the results. Handicap Adjusted Awards will be given to the highest placed archers in any category who have not been given a place award in any of the four categories above (and who have notified the organiser of their current handicap before they start shooting)

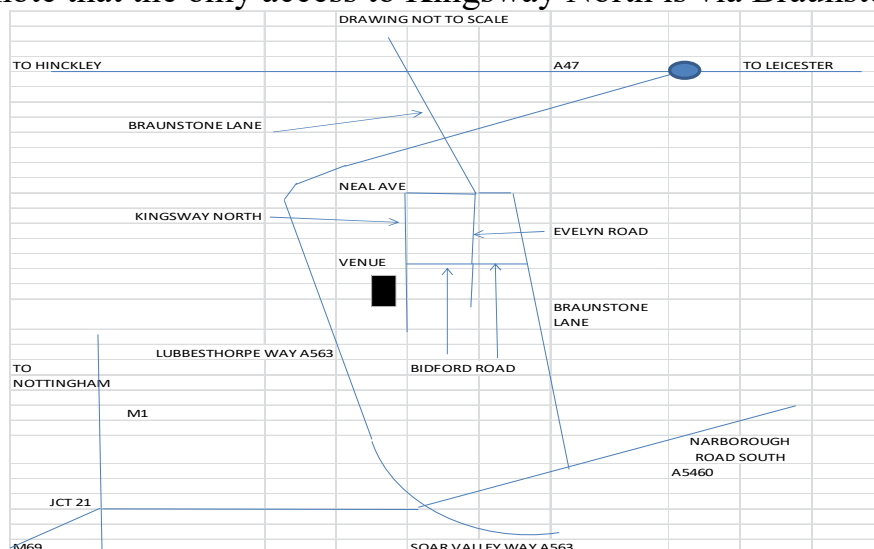
Closing date: Saturday 26th October 2019 or when the event is full; no refunds will be given after the closing date. Late entries might be accepted at the organiser's discretion.

Notes

1. All competitors must be affiliated to ArcheryGB or a World Archery member organisation and must show their 2019/20 membership card or e-card on arrival. If you do not have a current card, you must provide proof that you have paid your affiliation fee to the Club you are representing at the event.
2. Shooting will be in accordance with ArcheryGB rules of shooting; all archers must comply with ArcheryGB rule 307 (dress regulations); and shooting will be in timed ends of 3 arrows in 2 minutes.
3. Compound archers will shoot on Triple Spot faces with 2 archers shooting at each face. All other bow types will shoot on Single Spot faces, also with 2 archers shooting at each face.
4. All archers will shoot on straw bosses. There will be up to 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details. Provisional target lists will be posted on the club website after the closing date and sent to all entrants who provide a valid email address.
5. Equipment inspection will take place prior to assembly.
6. Double entries will be accepted, 1st round only will count for awards and the Countesthorpe Triple. Archers who are given a place award in a category will not be considered for a Handicap Adjusted Award.
7. The Foxes will not accept liability for any damage to or loss of archery equipment, cars or personal possessions on the site nor for injury to any person(s) incurred during this tournament.
8. Under the provisions of the AGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event must register with the organisers on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, The Foxes, the organisers and working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code. We therefore request that you report any unauthorised photography directly to the organisers.
9. Winstanley Community College is a no-smoking area and smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) are prohibited in all areas of the campus.
10. Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Archers under 18, a parent or guardian signing the entry signifies their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
11. **Data Protection** – When you enter this competition, you are agreeing that information will be collected and might be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, other competitors and may be published on web sites. For example target lists and results may be published containing some of the following information: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow Style, Date of Birth/Age category, Email, Home Address, contact Phone Number, Club, AGB membership number, County, Region, Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info. Contact information may be used by The Foxes to send you information about future events organised by the club.
